

Concrete Finisher Responsibilities:

Is a tradesman who works with concrete. Smooth and finish surfaces of poured concrete, such as floors, walks, sidewalks, roads, or curbs using a variety of hand and power tools. Align forms for sidewalks, curbs, or gutters; patch voids; and use saws to cut expansion joints.

Concrete Finisher Duties:

- Placing, finishing, protecting and repairing concrete in engineering and construction projects.
- Setting the concrete forms, ensuring they have the correct depth and pitch.
- Place concrete either directly from the concrete wagon chute, concrete pump, concrete skip or wheelbarrow.
- Spread, level, and smooth concrete, using rake, shovel, hand or power trowel, hand or power screed, and float.
- Mold expansion joints and edges, using edging tools, jointers, and straightedge.
- To finish trowel, broom, sweat and stamped for outdoor and interior concrete. Should know how to use power trowels and riders.
- Apply hardening and sealing compounds to cure surface of concrete, and waterproof or restore surface.

Concrete Finisher Skills and Qualifications:

The work is fast paced and strenuous and often involves kneeling, bending, and reaching, Work is full time, requires proper safety gear and protective clothing.
