

Concrete Labor Responsibilities:

Is the assistance to the tradesman who works with concrete.

Concrete Labor Duties:

- Mop, brush or spread paint, cleaning solutions, or other compound over surfaces to clean them or to provide protection.
- Operate jackhammers and drills to break up concrete or pavement.
- Place, consolidate, and protect case-in-place concrete or masonry structures.
- Position, join align, and seal structural components, such as concrete wall sections and concrete forms.
- Rake, shovel, vibrate and compact cement or soil materials and spread into form or rake on or under floors.
- Signal equipment operators to facilitate alignment, movement, and adjustment of machinery, equipment, and materials.

Concrete Labor Skills and Qualifications:

The work is fast paced and strenuous and often involves heavy lifting, kneeling, bending, and reaching. Work is full time, requires proper safety gear, protective clothing and you must be in good health to meet the stamina and regiment.
